Vivek Ramaswamy	Dept Gov Eff	Entrepreneur and biotech investor; no public administration or government experience.	Privatization of public services may reduce access to programs that support marginalized communities.
Scott Bessent	Treasury Sec	Hedge fund manager; limited experience in governmental fiscal policy or administration.	Financial market focus could limit access to capital for Black-owned businesses.
Howard Lutnick	Commerce Sec	CEO of Cantor Fitzgerald; extensive experience in financial markets but no background in commerce policy or economic development.	Corporate favoring over small businesses may reduce opportunities for Black entrepreneurs.
Linda McMahon	Dep. of Education	Former WWE CEO; no experience in education policy or administration.	Cuts in programs like Title I and Pell Grants could disproportionately impact low-income Black students.
Doug Burgum	Interior Sec	Governor of North Dakota; limited experience in land management or conservation, Interior's primary focus.	Deregulation of land use may harm Black communities and reduce urban green space investment.
Stephen Feinberg	Deputy Def Sec	Founder of Cerberus Capital; no military or defense experience.	Defense contracting prioritization may reduce focus on diversity and opportunities for Black military personnel.
Warren Stephens	Ambassador to UK	Investment banker; no diplomatic experience.	Diplomatic inexperience may hinder trade policies impacting Black businesses.
Charles Kushner	Ambassador to France	Real estate developer; no diplomatic experience.	Strained international relations could impact programs supporting Black entrepreneurs or students abroad.
Mehmet Oz	CMS Admin	TV personality and cardiothoracic surgeon; no experience in Medicaid/Medicare systems.	Reduced access to essential healthcare services under Medicare/Medicaid administration.
Frank Bisignano	Social Security Commissioner	CEO of Fiserv; no experience in Social Security policy or administration.	Mismanagement could delay or cut Social Security benefits, harming older Black Americans and those with disabilities.
Kelly Loeffler	SBA	Former U.S. Senator and businesswoman; no experience in small business administration.	Favoring corporations may limit support for Black-owned small businesses.
David Sacks	Crypto Commissioner	Venture capitalist; no regulatory or governmental experience in cryptocurrency.	Inadequate crypto regulation could exacerbate wealth disparities and harm Black investors.
Jared Isaacman	NASA Administrator	Entrepreneur and private astronaut; no experience managing a large federal agency or space program.	Deprioritization of STEM outreach and education could limit opportunities for Black students.
